


**DECLARATION OF AARON ZISSER**

AARON ZISSER, declares under penalty of perjury, that the following is true and correct:

1. I am an attorney at the Public Interest Law Center of Philadelphia. I am a member of the bar of the State of New York.
2. On October 21, 2008, I talked twice with John Day. Mr. Day is the Chief Supervisor in the Voting Machine Warehouse of the Philadelphia board of elections where machines in Philadelphia county are assigned to election districts.
3. The facts set forth in paragraph 4 below as to assignment of machines to voting districts in Philadelphia are based on those two conversations and upon information faxed to me by Mr. Day.
4. Philadelphia has 1,681 election districts. Four districts, each with fewer than 50 registered voters, are assigned one machine per district. One hundred forty-four districts are each assigned 3 machines, 9 districts are each assigned 4 machines, and 1 district is assigned 5 machines. The remaining 1,523 districts are each assigned two machines for election day.

I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct to the best of my knowledge. Executed this 22<sup>nd</sup> day of October, 2008
