

Report problems with electronic voting machines on Election Day.

YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO VOTE.

YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO HAVE YOUR VOTE COUNTED.

ON ELECTION DAY, YOU MAY NEED TO KNOW YOUR RIGHTS IF YOU WANT TO EXERCISE THEM.

**Many things can come between you and your ability to cast your vote.
Even more can come between your vote being cast and your vote being counted.
Here are some of the steps you can take should voting problems arise so you can
stand up for yourself, make your voice heard and be counted.**

PROBLEM: Long lines? Worried the polls will close while you are in line before you can vote?

ACTION: 1) Do not give up. Do not leave.
2) Remember, you have a right to vote because you were already in line at the time the polls closed.
3) Call any election hotline and ask that they issue a request to the courts to order the polls to stay open late.

PROBLEM: Machine switches vote on screen, or appears to malfunction as you cast your vote.

ACTION: 1) DO NOT PUSH THE FINAL BUTTON TO CAST YOUR VOTE. Once you push that button, you cannot change your vote.
2) Find an election judge (poll supervisor) and insist that the problem be fixed before you push the final button to cast your vote.
3) If the voting machine will not accept your votes as you intend, request to vote on a different machine that works properly.
4) Call an election hotline and report the machine brand, model and serial number and the precinct location.

PROBLEM: Poll worker is unresponsive to your requests.

ACTION: Call an election hotline and report the poll worker's name and the location of the polling place.

PROBLEM: Worried about accessibility at the polls?

ACTION: Bring a family member or friend who can assist you or call your local party officials for help.

PROBLEM: Don't see your problem listed here?

ACTION: Call toll free 1-877-VOTE-COUNT and talk with an expert about your concerns.

REMEMBER: When in doubt...Call election hotlines. These are your advocates. The people staffing election hotlines will work with you to make sure you can vote, your vote is counted and to hold elections officials and voting machine makers accountable for avoidable mistakes and malfunctions.
